Mandatory Use. Such grantees must adopt these guidelines by no later than the later of (1) October 1, 2012 (the beginning of FFY 2013); or (2) the beginning of their fiscal years. And the maximum annual SSI benefit amount for a single individual is \$9,396 (\$783 / month).
