For low-light situations, an exit pupil of 5mm or more is good: At dawn, dusk or with dense tree cover, having a high exit pupil number can make viewing easier. For bright daylight viewing , exit pupil size is less important because almost all binoculars offer exit pupils that exceed 2mm.
