Older lenses that were manual focus, like the legacy Nikon F-mount lenses, had brilliant optics and control, but no brain. Unlike modern lenses that are 'chipped', they couldn't digitally communicate with the camera, so there was no AF, and couldn't even speak automatically to the cameras to tell them what aperture they were at, and what focal length so metering properly was non-existent.

Nikon's entry-level DSLRs will not autofocus with many older lenses which don't have a built-in AF motor. Nikon makes an adapter to fit F-mount lenses to its 1 System mirrorless cameras, but again only lenses with built-in motors will autofocus. Olympus / Panasonic

Nikon DX format DSLRs have a crop factor of 1.5x. As a result, the focal length of all compatible lenses will be 'extended'. Hence, in this case, the focal length of the 50mm f/1.8G becomes the equivalent of a 75mm lens mounted on a 35mm camera. At 75mm the lens could be used as a decent portrait shooter as well.
