It was coined by Thomas Carlyle, a nineteenth-century Scottish historian, but is often erroneously attributed to Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels. It was, however, Marx and Engels who popularized the concept in their writings and fueled use of the phrase within the fields of political economy and sociology.

In many ways, The Cash Nexus is a conservative response to The Rise and Fall of the Great Powers, a 1988 work by historian Paul Kennedy that contended that the United States, by spending too much money on the military, was suffering from "imperial overstretch" and would lose the economic war with Germany and Japan. Ferguson argues that, after the Cold War, the reverse is true—that an American elite afraid of casualties in foreign wars is abandoning its role as the world's policeman.
